**ATR VERDICT:** The Lock Master looks a winner in waiting but his best efforts in recent months have come on the slower Fibresand at Southwell. Preference is therefore for AQUARIAN SPIRIT, who rattled off a quick 1m double at Lingfield in January and, raised only 2lb for his last-time-out neck success, is expected to improve over this longer trip. Archie Rice bids for a remarkable fifth consecutive victory when running at this venue and cannot be left out of calculations, nor can the unexposed Son Vida, who warrants a market check on his return from a prolonged absence.
