ATR VERDICT: MONSIEUR PONTAVEN rattled the crossbar over C&D last month, going down by less than a length off 1lb lower, and gets the vote here in hope he can build upon that effort from his low draw. Look For Love was another to go close over this track and trip latest and, off the same mark, appears the principal threat. Blue Noodles was putting in his best work in the finish over 6f last time and merits consideration over this longer trip along with top-weight Gala Spirit and Kyncraighe, for whom the booking of Jamie Spencer for the Joseph Tuite yard looks significant.

ATR VERDICT: An open-looking contest in which **NORVILLE** is taken to come out on top. David Evans' gelding progressed at the rate of knots in the first half of last year, after which time the assessor appeared to have his measure. However, having now dropped 2lb lower than his last winning mark, the selection is taken to deliver on a promising Lingfield fourth last time, stepped up to a trip over which he is unexposed. Back in fifth in the same race, **Piscean** is down to a good mark and merits consideration along with **Oil Strike**, who could improve on his first run for Mick Easterby.

ATR VERDICT: The Lock Master looks a winner in waiting but his best efforts in recent months have come on the slower Fibresand at Southwell. Preference is therefore for AQUARIAN SPIRIT, who rattled off a quick 1m double at Lingfield in January and, raised only 2lb for his last-time-out neck success, is expected to improve over this longer trip. Archie Rice bids for a remarkable fifth consecutive victory when running at this venue and cannot be left out of calculations, nor can the unexposed Son Vida, who warrants a market check on his return from a prolonged absence.

ATR VERDICT: Maison Brillet hinted his turn was near when beaten by just a nose over 2m at Lingfield last time and another bold bid looks assured, despite a 3lb rise in the weights. Preference, however, is for MOUNT ABORA, who wasn't helped by the moderate pace when third here last week and remains on a fair mark, 5lb higher than when winning over 1m4f last month. The selection does, however, need to prove his stamina for the trip. If he fails to stay, C&D winner Mr Plod could feasibly figure in the shake-up.
