**ATR VERDICT:** CAPPA BLEU put up a brave effort when chasing home two Chepstow specialists in the Welsh National, confirming his Haydock comeback win was no fluke. The 2009 Foxhunter Chase hero is still lightly raced for a ten-year-old and he's worth another chance off this mark back on more suitable ground. The Minack seems to have really come of age this term but a 9lb rise for his C&D success in December will not be easy to overcome. Peter Marsh runner-up Pearlysteps has another 3lb to contend with but remains realistically treated, while Penny Max is the unexposed eye-catcher towards the foot of the weights and he merits close attention in his bid to complete the hat-trick.
