ATR VERDICT: KAUTO STONE remains a prospect of the highest order and can resume winning ways having last been seen chasing home the brilliant Sizing Europe in the Tingle Creek back in December. Already a Grade 1 winner in his native France, Paul Nicholls' charge has been given a nice break since that personal best performance at Sandown and should have underfoot conditions to suit today as he bids to claim his first top-level success on these shores. Last year's winner Riverside Theatre makes his first start since, following injury, and plenty of attention is sure to surround the one-time King George runner-up. However he performs today, though, he is entitled to improve. Medermit seems sure to be on the premises following a string of fine efforts so far this season, while Gauvain's overall profile suggests a clear round of jumping should see last year's runner-up involved once again.
