ATR VERDICT: Le Beau Bai and Giles Cross locked horns for the length of the Chepstow straight in the Welsh National, with the Richard Lee-trained former forcing Giles Cross to fill the runner-up spot for the second successive renewal. The form may be reversed now that Giles Cross meets his conqueror on 7lb better terms, but both may have to settle for minor honours because FREDO improved markedly for a test of stamina in the 3m5f Classic Chase at Warwick - with Major Malarkey behind him - and he doesn't have too many miles on the clock over fences. Some Target, a rare runner here for Irish champion trainer Willie Mullins, has also been crying out for a rise to this sort of distance, and much better is anticipated from him.
