ATR VERDICT: CARLOSWAYBACK lost his way somewhat over hurdles but looks to have gone the other way since being sent over the larger obstacles, improving with every start so far and an impressive winner at Punchestown last month. This is markedly tougher but trainer Paul Nolan holds the seven-year-old in some regard and he looks to have the required pace to cope with this drop back in trip. Delphi Mountain has been well-held in a couple of Grade 2 events recently and needs to improve more than Far Away So Close, second the last twice but evidently useful judged on some smart form over hurdles. The talented Donnas Palm is another who could figure if putting his best foot forward.
