ATR VERDICT: Ballyalton landed a Warwick bumper by 18l on his first start under Rules last month and is very much respected, despite his mandatory penalty. In receipt of 7lb from the first-named, however, a chance is taken on PEBBLEGLLEN. The Tim Easterby-trained six-year-old is a son of Milan and fetched 48,000 euros in 2007. A market check is essential in assessing the confidence behind his chances on his racecourse bow today. Penalised C&D winner Kayersberg completes the shortlist.
