ATR VERDICT: This looks an ideal opportunity for TRANQUIL SEA to get his Ryanair preparations back on track. Edward O'Grady's ten-year-old missed last year's Festival after an unsatisfactory scope and hasn't built upon his seasonal reappearance victory at Clonmel as hoped, with his declining official rating indicative of the way his season has panned out. Nevertheless, on his favoured soft ground, and with C&D winning form to his name, a big run looks on the cards from the 2010 John Durkan (Grade 1) winner. Seabass has progressed through the handicap ranks this term and is feared most, with the enigmatic Zaarito in with place claims if putting his best foot forward.
