ATR VERDICT: FRANCO IS MY NAME appears to have been found a great opportunity to regain the winning thread. He ran up to something like his best when runner-up over 1m4f at Lingfield just short of four weeks ago (third and fourth have won since) and he's entitled to strip fitter for that first start since August. From the opposite end of the handicap, Sand Skier rates a big threat having run well off this mark over 1m5f at Lingfield latest, while Battleoftrafalgar is currently 7lb lower than when last winning cannot be ruled out.
