ATR VERDICT: COLOUR GUARD is tough to oppose in the finale for Mark Johnston as his son of Shamardal is given another chance off this mark of 75 in what looks a more realistic assignment. He caught the eye when shedding his maiden tag over the 7f here at the beginning of last month and is open to plenty of improvement. Minortransgression boasts C&D winning form and looks the most likely to cause the selection problems but the remainder may be forced to settle for supporting roles, Sir George appealing most of those.
