ATR VERDICT: John Wade landed this pot as a trainer last year with Always Right and bids to follow up as an owner with the Keith Reveley-trained Benny Be Good. He may just struggle at the top of the weights, though, and with that in mind Junior and NEPTUNE EQUESTER are preferred. The former, who won the Kim Muir in great style last year, is as short as 12-1 for the Grand National next month, but the selection gets in under a low weight for this event and looks to have conditions in his favour. Brian Ellison's gelding won at Haydock over 3m4f earlier this term and may have since found the deep winter ground against him. Also keep an eye on the Aintree-bound West End Rocker, who was back to his best at the Liverpool track in the Becher Chase when last sighted in December.
