ATR VERDICT: It's difficult to look past PEKING TO PARIS representing the Willie/Patrick Mullins combination who have cleaned up in these races down the years. The seven-year-old son of Flemensfirth made a promising start to his racing career when runner-up in bottomless conditions at Fairyhouse four weeks ago and should go one better if stepping forward from that. Kasszec warrants respect on her NH debut having won between the flags at Durrow last month, while Cross To Boston appears to be heading the right way and has place claims.
