ATR VERDICT: Tom George appears to hold a strong hand here and, while Be Definite has now placed on six of his last eight starts (including one win), it could be worth siding with BACK BOB BACK. The C&D winner was nothing but impressive at the Berkshire track three starts ago but has struggled over 2m at Uttoxeter and Warwick since. The handicapper has dropped him 2lb, though, and another chance is given now back up in trip. Pepite Rose is another to take seriously.
