ATR VERDICT: Nelson du Ronceray was lucky to emerge on top in a handicap hurdle here last time but his strike-rate over fences is an enviable one and another big run looks assured. However, marginal preference is for MALLUSK. He didn't seem to get the trip when stepped back up to 2m5f at Lingfield but had previously been going well over 2m and looks worth another chance off his present handicap mark, especially with conditions in his favour. Comfortable Sedgefield scorer The Thirsty Bricky is also accorded respect.
