ATR VERDICT: SOUDAIN hadn't played his hand when unseating his rider at Catterick and can resume his progression from the same mark here. Sir Mangan might emerge as a leading danger as he was pitched into a stronger 0-140 handicap following a comfortable victory at Sedgefield the time before. This looks an ideal opportunity for him to bounce back, likewise for Purcell's Bridge, who struggled at Doncaster from a 2lb higher mark, but had scored impressively at Musselburgh prior to that. The stablemate pairing of The Friary and Itstimeforapint warrant closer inspection while any support for King Of The Wolds should be noted.
