ATR VERDICT: Dark Ocean won last year's renewal off 4lb lower and it is interesting that Jedd O'Keeffe, who enjoyed a double on the card 12 months ago, has again secured the services of Graham Lee. He's expected to go well on his return, while similar sentiments apply to the hat-trick-seeking Trinity Star, but the verdict goes to the race-fit MARCIANO, as he has been kept busy on the all-weather at Southwell and won a competitive handicap there in February by five lengths.

ATR VERDICT: Both DANNYDAY and Ya Hade Ye Delil hold entries in the Derby and the former is expected to have improved plenty from two to three. Representing the Sir Michael Stoute yard, one of just two horses for the former champion trainer at this meeting, the son of Dansili wasn't beaten far by subsequent Group 3 Autumn Stakes winner Commemorative on his Doncaster debut last September. The 79-rated Secateur represents another powerful stable, but Richard Hannon's Ya Hade Ye Delil is feared most on the back of his recent Kempton effort.

ATR VERDICT: Danot is interesting on his debut for the Jedd O'Keeffe, the same stable that won the race 12 months ago with New Bidder, and he boasts a plum draw in stall one. Teruntum Star is the class horse in the race and is dropped back into handicap company on his seasonal bow, but GRANDAD'S WORLD was deemed good enough to contest a hot sales race at Doncaster as a juvenile and the course winner ran a blinder to finish a close-up seventh behind stable companion Bond's Girl. He's taken to overcome a potentially tricky draw in stall eight.

ATR VERDICT: SUPRISE VENDOR hasn't been seen in this sphere since winning this race at odds of 20-1 last year, but he has been kept busy over hurdles and another bold showing looks assured. The nine-year-old made all the running from 7lb out of the handicap 12 months ago, seeing off the late challenge of Fitzwilly and Calculated Risk, and off just a 5lb higher mark he's expected to go close again. Scrafton is relatively unexposed and must be taken seriously judged on wins at Newcastle and Catterick last September, while Harvey's Hope rates best of the rest.
