**ATR VERDICT:** A case can easily be made for a number of these, but DREAMLIKE is the one who excites most. The form of each of her three performances as a juvenile is rock-solid, particularly when chasing home subsequent Musidora winner Star Of Seville at Doncaster in October, and she is expected to make up into an even better three-year-old. Stepping up a quarter of a mile could also unlock further improvement. Pulcinella faces no easy task conceding weight all round, but her comeback third at Ascot took a big boost when the winner followed up in a Listed event at the Dante meeting. Tazffin, Cartier and Music And Dance add further spice to the race.
