Chenega Bay is feared most despite rattling the crossbar for the third successive time at Fairyhouse, but Seaforth and Mutadhamen also have live chances after decent efforts.

ATR VERDICT: SPINAMISS outperformed market expectations when running a cracker to fill the runner-up spot at the Curragh on her introduction. She got the better of Vitello on that occasion, and that one has subsequently beaten Flirt at Fairyhouse. That collateral form heightens the appeal of Paul Deegan's youngster, but Flirt is improving and shouldn't be dismissed out of hand. Orangey Red makes her debut for leading connections, and both Optimism And Hope and Hot To The Touch deserve market inspection.

ATR VERDICT: Duchessofflorence sets the standard but has had plenty of chances and may prove vulnerable to some of the less exposed types. ATR VERDICT: BENKEI won with plenty to spare at Navan, scampering clear under hands and heels, and the step up to this trip is expected to suit. A 10lb rise demands more of Harry Rogers' charge, but he was beaten just over a length by Clondaw Warrior (Ascot Stakes winner off 89 on Tuesday) last September, so a mark of 74 should be within his reach. Hazariban ought to be thereabouts and is respected, while Hurricane Ridge and Plinth can also play a part.
