ATR VERDICT: Derby entrant Tyrannical should be monitored in the betting ring, while Rock Warbler is another interesting newcomer for a leading yard. Dark Devil made a pleasing introduction when bustling up Arcanada at Chester (third a subsequent winner) and should be on the premises, but a chance is taken on BEAST MODE. Peter Chapple-Hyam's youngster displayed inexperience when only finishing in mid-division on debut at Newmarket but the form of that race has been working out reasonably well and the Cape Cross colt is expected to progress. Silver Streak, rather disappointing at Beverley latest, is another to consider.
