ATR VERDICT: Simon Crisford introduces a potentially smart gelding in the shape of Zanjabeel and, one of just two rides on the card for Paul Hanagan, the market should tell us more. Preference is for those with experience, though, and KNIGHTS TABLE edges the verdict from White Poppy. James Tate saddled a winner for these connections at Beverley last week and his son of Sir Percy should take some stopping if running up to his mark of 80 and recapturing the form which saw him finish a nose second over C&D last month.
