ATR VERDICT: Ninepointsixthree sets the standard based on his last two runner-up finishes at Exeter and his official rating of 115. That said, it would not be a big surprise to see one of his rivals today improve past him. SOUPY SOUPS is a point-to-point and bumper winner on good ground and the soft going could be the reason for his distant third over hurdles last November. The form of his bumper win is strong, as the useful Templeross was second, and the son of Stowaway can be given another chance on this sound surface. Indy Five and The Tailgater are others to make the shortlist.

On form, the only real danger is War Singer but he will have to improve on his recent second on chasing debut to trouble the Paul Nicholls representative. Both King Of Milan and The Society Man would need the main two protagonists to have a mishap to be successful, although the former would be the pick of that pair.
