The second had finished third in the Fred Winter back in March and the third was a highly-rated Flat recruit. Colin's Sister won well at the same venue the day before and could prove to be the main danger with her sex allowance. Templeross has looked to be above-average so far in his short career and is another to note, while neither Black Warrior and Pickamix cannot be completely discounted.
