







ATR VERDICT: Casper King brings the most solid hurdling form to the table but appears to be not the most trustworthy having hung left when runner-up behind Geordie Des Champs at Chepstow earlier in the month. Nicky Henderson fields an interesting pair in Khezerabad, who will appreciate this sound surface, and Thomas Campbell, an impressive winner of a bumper at Kelso in May, but preference goes to GARO DE JUILLEY. The son of Ungaro won four on the Flat in France, achieving a fairly decent level, and makes his debut for Paul Nicholls team who has been fairly bullish about him as a hurdling prospect. Accord showed some ability on hurdling debut behind Peter The Mayo Man at Warwick and is best of the remainder.
