ATR VERDICT: THE ORANGE ROGUE found improvement with a first-time tongue-tie last time out and won't mind some give in the ground off 4lb higher under Brian Hughes for the first time. The 10-year-old has been found a decent chance to follow up and he can take it at the expense of Spoils Of War, who wears blinkers for the first time and remains in solid form. Achill Road Boy wasn't given the best of rides last time out and could go well if kept closer to the pace.
