







ATR VERDICT: Cogry's jumping will always be a worry but he has completed his last two starts over fences and has been dropped 2lb in the ratings for finishing sixth in the Midlands National last month. KNOCKANRAWLEY has not had much racing in the last couple of years but he has made the frame in the Classic Chase at Warwick and the Eider at Newcastle in his two starts this season. Aubusson has tumbled down the ratings this season and it would be no surprise if he went well at big odds, while Potters Cross could bounce back to form following two moderate efforts.
