ATR VERDICT: Venetia Williams is always worth a second look at this South Wales venue and her Cold March must enter calculations. However, he struggled at the Cheltenham last time and a chance may be worth taking on the tough and durable ULCK DU LIN, who is back down to his last winning mark and Festival-winning amateur pilot Bryony Frost takes a further 7lb off the back of the experienced Paul Nicholls campaigner. Red Spinner is also respected in the first time cheekpieces and with Sam Twiston-Davies is an eye-catching jockey booking, he is entitled to play a part in the finish.
