ATR VERDICT: All four of these runners tried to force the pace, with varying degrees of success, on their recent starts so tactics could play a big part in the outcome here. PERFECT TIMING has to contend with an 11lb rise after dotting up at Huntingdon last time but he may just be the in-form horse to side with. Little Windmill won here yesterday and a 7lb penalty may not be enough to prevent another bold bid if turned out again quickly, while The Mumper and Lemon's Gent both have some recent form to give them a chance.
