**ATR VERDICT:** The Italian Yob has run well from the front over 2m5f the last twice but has faded in the closing stages. He'll need to draw on deeper reserves of stamina now stepped up in trip, so it may pay to side with GOLANOVA, who was narrowly behind the first-named at Fontwell last month but, by contrast, appeared to be tapped for toe in third. He may turn the tables on that rival now reopposing over this longer trip. Gold Mountain had no sort of race when unseating his rider at the second at Chepstow latest but he was sent off joint-favourite. It will thus be interesting to see if the money is down for him again.
