ATR VERDICT: A competitive heat despite the small field but the preference has to be for OPENING BATSMAN, who finally took advantage of a falling handicap mark when successful at Ludlow earlier in the month. A 6lb rise in the ratings does make life harder today but the veteran remains a long way below his peak rating of 148. Alcala did not have much to beat at Ludlow on Tuesday but it confirmed him to be in good form, although the quick turnaround would have to be a minor worry. Gowanauthat just edges out The Fresh Prince as the best of the rest.
