**ATR VERDICT:** A quality renewal claimed by Ballydoyle last season and they look to hold strong claims once more with ALPHABET. The former David Wachman-trained three-year-old made a promising start to life in Tipperary, hosing up at Naas last month. She probably didn't beat a great deal there but looks to have improved plenty with age and for the change of scenery and could account for stablemate Intelligence Cross, who probably needed the run at Dundalk last time out. Psychedelic Funk sets a decent form standard on his Coventry Stakes third at Royal Ascot, while the promising Son Of Rest is another to consider.
