ATR VERDICT: The Queen's CALL TO MIND is entered in the Derby and the King Edward VIII and the Galileo colt looks to provide a live chance of supplying a Royal winner in either the premier Classic for three-year-old colts or at Royal Ascot. He was a likeable victor over a mile at Newbury on debut despite showing signs of greenness and the step up in trip now looks the logical step towards his lofty mid season targets. Desert Skyline was a dual winner as a two-year-old and is interesting now reappearing while Valcartier was an eye-catching winner at Nottingham and could have plenty more to come. The main danger, however, may come from Leshlaa who looked to have a bit up his sleeve when winning a handicap over course and distance at the Guineas meeting and a strong follow up here would be no surprise.
