ATR VERDICT: Sir Michael Stoute's Ulysses looked a much more assured performer when landing the Gordon Richards Stakes at Sandown on his first start of the season, a performance which sent him straight to the top table of 10-furlong performers this term. He beat Deauville a length that day, with that horse looking a useful yardstick in this, as Decorated Knight had him three-and-a-half-lengths adrift when landing the Tattersalls Gold Cup at the Curragh last time and Roger Charlton's star is another to consider here. However, it is hard to get away from the claims of the well-travelled Coronation Cup winner HIGHLAND REEL, who drops back in trip looking to land another valuable victory to his growing collection of trophies. It is also worth noting Galileo has sired all three of the aforementioned and it looks set to be another Group One winner for the Coolmore super stud. Of the rest, Jack Hobbs has to be considered with the blinkers remaining in place following his Dubai Sheema Classic triumph. He hasn't been seen since however, and doubts remain over his ability to handle fast ground over this shorter distance with his very best efforts coming over further.
