The stiff finish here will play to his strengths and he can continue to progress through the handicap ranks. Okool disappointed when looking a non-stayer at Chester but does look to be fairly treated on the best of his maiden form and the Owen Burrows yard are in fine form with their three-year-old handicappers having had a double at the weekend.
