ATR VERDICT: Following a maiden success on soft ground at Carlisle, there was plenty to like about Charlie Appleby's PILGRIM'S TREASURE when a good second on a quick surface over this C&D and pulled well clear of the third. The Godolphin representative is up 3lb for that but has scope for plenty of further improvement after only four starts and is versatile with regards to underfoot conditions. Flying North is another improver and went close to a handicap double off a 2lb lower mark at Leicester latest, but the biggest danger may be Big Tour in the same colours as the selection. Saeed bin Suroor's inmate made it third time lucky when dominating a 1m maiden at Windsor and an opening mark of 82 looks fair.
