**TIMEFORM VIEW:** FINALE stands out here, not just on the basis of her convincing breakthrough success at Nottingham but also on account of her striking potential. Indeed, the Holy Roman Emperor filly is still unexposed, particularly on turf, and a 5 lb rise is unlikely to prevent her from going in again. Funky Footsteps is marginally preferred to Kyllachys Tale for forecast purposes.
