**ATR VERDICT:** OCEAN DRIVE was a little disappointing on turf debut but is worth another chance, having shaped well on both previous starts on an artificial surface. The step up in trip should assist her cause and she's preferred to opponents who look mainly exposed. Falcon Cliffs does not fall into that category and now has a first run for William Muir since leaving Joseph Tuite, but she will need to bounce back from a couple of modest efforts. Star Maker needs to put a poor run latest behind her too and it's Conkering Hero and Amelia Dream who could put up most resistance.
