ATR VERDICT: Dance Diva sets the standard despite losing her unbeaten record when runner-up in the Princess Margaret Stakes at Ascot. She'd previously landed a hat-trick and now steps up to 7f for the first time. Jousi appeals as an improver and has place claims at a price but MAYYASAH created a good visual impression when making a winning debut at Newbury and the value of the form is starting to look good. She is narrowly preferred to Poetic Charm, also a winner of her sole outing in useful maiden company and representing a yard that do well with their juveniles here.
