He is entitled to improve and must enter calculations, along with Addicted To You who slammed Galway Hurdle sixth Project Bluebook prior to twisting a shoe at Ayr. Mark Hopkins, Look My Way and Grumeti are others to note but preference is for talented dual purpose performer ROLLING MAUL. He built on his Bath success when trouncing the opposition at Ffos Las and a further 6lb rise might not be enough to stop him completing the hat-trick.
