ATR VERDICT: Swiss Cottage made a promising start to his racing when a staying-on fifth over 7f here and he can improve for this step up in trip, while Mendelssohn is expected to leave his debut eighth well behind representing the stable that won this race in both 2014 and 2016. Andesh is sure to have plenty of supporters given his connections and warrants respect, but a chance is taken on another newcomer in THE KING. The 140,000gns purchase is certainly bred to have plenty of ability, being a half-brother to five winners including Group 3 scorer Lightning Moon, and an entry in next year's Epsom Derby suggests that he's been burning up the gallops at home.
