**ATR VERDICT:** It might pay to side with the top-rated MAJOR VALENTINE in a tight little handicap. The five-year-old seemed to handle a deeper surface when third at Nottingham and, with talented conditional Ben Robinson amongst the winners of late, he can steer his mount to another podium finish, possibly gold. Wiley Post warrants respect lining up off the same mark as when runner-up over C&D, while Vimy Ridge is well treated on best form.
