Simon Crisford's charge impressed when landing a Lingfield maiden in stylish fashion but the wheels rather come off at Newmarket when he was last seen out in the spring. He had excuses for that reverse however having lost a shoe mid-race and may have more to offer now down in class after a gelding operation. Helovaplan looked progressive before seeming to struggle in the soft ground at Doncaster last time out but there are showers forecast and his connections will be hoping that the rain stays away. Fujaira Bridge rates best of the rest.
