The form of that race has been franked by the third landing a Turkish Group Three, while the fourth was a worthy second in a hot Haydock contest last weekend. Ballydoyle saddle two runners in Curragh winner Mendelssohn and Seahenge, who was chasing Expert Eye's shadow last time at Goodwood. The unbeaten Godolphin candidate Mythical Magic is sure to be popular and is foolish to dismiss, however, there was a lot to like about the way DREAM TODAY landed the Corvival Stakes at York last time on his racecourse debut. That looked to be only scratching the surface of his potential and there should be plenty more to come.
