ATR VERDICT: Thammin may well have needed the run for Owen Burrows at Lingfield in May and remains lightly raced in this sphere, while the consistent Foxy Forever is more than capable in this grade and rates as a danger to all if in the right mood. Midnightly did it well at Wolverhampton last time and could be dangerous if allowed an easy lead, but this race could pan out perfectly for ORVAR, who takes a big drop in class and should have plenty of pace to aim at here from stall one.
