ATR VERDICT: Welsby must enter calculations given his connections, similarly Russian Spy, who represents an Evan Williams stable going great guns at the moment. However, it may pay to concentrate on the point-to-point form of Henry's Joy and NET DE TREVE. The former only found subsequent bumper scorer Rapid Escape (also fifth in the Goffs Land Rover) too good on his latest of two starts between the flags at Tinahely and the booking of Richard Johnson is a big plus for his supporters, but slight preference is for the latter. He represents the same trainer/jockey combination that won this event 12 months ago and the form of his point-to-point second at Inch in April took a big boost when the winner finished a close-up third in a bumper at Chepstow on Wednesday.
