ATR VERDICT: OAK VINTAGE lost little in defeat when finishing a short-head second to John Williams at Hexham last month and with that rival franking the form at Musselburgh last week, the selection is expected to remain competitive off a 1lb higher mark and follow suit. Betancourt struck over hurdles off 8lb lower at Sedgefield last month and is worth a market check on his fencing bow, while Petapenko is back from a long break and debuts for a new trainer so could similarly take a hand.
