ATR VERDICT: Helmsley Lad is entitled to improve for his Sedgefield reappearance and is more than capable of landing this. However, his free-going style of running leaves him vulnerable late on and he could get picked off once again here, with the in-form BENNY'S SECRET expected to go well. Nick Alexander's seven-year-old was brave when scoring over course and distance last time and could have plenty still in hand here off a mark of 104. Cape Of Glory and Craig Star look closely matched on their Sedgefield run in the summer, with the latter having come out and won over track and trip since. They are two other potential improvers to consider.
