ATR VERDICT: The unexposed DELFACE won well on his first run for the Pipe team when last seen in May when the yard were struggling for the winners, and he looks poised to go close here despite going up in class on his reappearance. An opening handicap mark of 119 doesn't look too harsh, and the son of Della Francesca is fancied to continue his progress. General Ginger likely needed the run last time and should do better here, while Prussian Eagle isn't one to rule out under his excellent claiming rider.
