








ATR VERDICT: FAIR FRANK was most impressive on his chase debut at Southwell last month, jumping well out in front and staying on strongly over this trip. There should be more to come from this six-year-old and a 6lb rise in the weights might not be enough to halt him under top conditional rider Mitchell Bastyan. Mr Jim is a big player on his comeback if returning in a similar mood to when finishing second at Towcester in May, while Larkhall completes the shortlist.
