**ATR VERDICT:** Ballydine brings the best form to the table, based on his second-placed finish to Barbers Hill in a Grade 2 novice hurdle, but the 607-day break is an obvious concern. Rolling Dylan won a handicap off a mark of 132 last time out but the 5lb penalty he has to carry today leaves him vulnerable. With that in mind, the preference is for SAINTE LADYLIME, who also has to carry a penalty but being a mare, she still gets weight from her rivals this afternoon. The six-year-old beat a talented rival last time out and she has an obvious chance today.
