ATR VERDICT: JUST GEORGIE came in for solid support on his return to chasing when second at Bangor last time out and was unlucky behind a well-treated animal. He looks well worth a go over this extra distance and could take advantage of a winnable opening. Purple Harry did it well at Kelso when last seen in May but looks likely to be using this to prepare for the Eider Chase at Newcastle early next year, while the consistent Whiskey Chaser isn't easy to win with but should be thereabouts.
